Background:	In February 2017, Coyote Creek flooded and wreaked havoc in San Jose. Sadly, the bee
	apiary at Happy Hollow Park & Zoo was destroyed. These beehives teach people how to care
	for bees and raises \$15,000 a year in honey sales to protect the mountain gorillas at Virunga
	National Park in the Congo. Thankfully, a dedicated team led by Happy Hollow "Bee Guy,"
	Steve Demkowski rallied quickly. With financial support from the Farrington Foundation,
	Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors, with advocacy led by Supervisor Cindy Chavez,
	and hundreds of donors, the bees are buzzing again at Happy Hollow Park & Zoo.
