## MONARCH MEADOW

More than 200 volunteers descended upon Happy Hollow Park & Zoo for Monarch Meadow Weekend October 7-8, 2023 to install over 700 plants and hundreds of yards of mulch to create a large-scale pollinator friendly garden which is a milestone achievement in conservation, biodiversity and habitat restoration. This capital improvement project was made possible by the financial and volunteer support of: UA Local 393, Kimley-Horn, KPMG, Beautiful Day, multiple agencies with the City of San José and Happy Hollow Foundation donors.

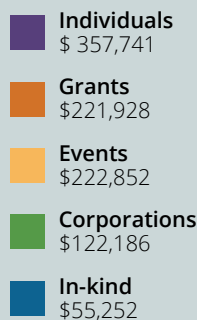
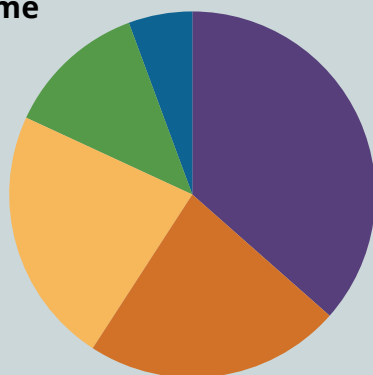

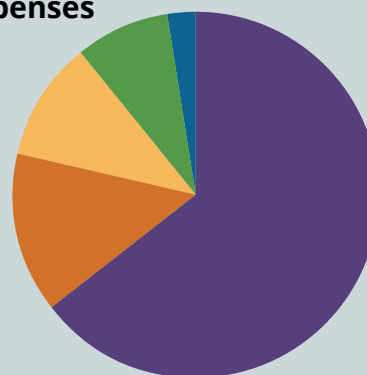
### Income
