Our vision is to foster pride and involvement so that Happy Hollow Park & Zoo remains a community asset that is highly valued and accessible to all.

In collaboration with the City of San José and local partners, the Foundation funds educational opportunities for underserved students, supports upgrades to zoo exhibits and rides, assists in funding animal care and enrichment tools, and administers conservation grants locally and globally.





For 63 years, Happy Hollow Park & Zoo has connected San José residents to nature through play. In partnership with the City of San José and supporters like you, Happy Hollow Foundation continues to make a difference both near and far through advocating for and supporting conservation, education and play.

- Donations have helped renovate Meet & Greet Corner which is utilized daily by animal ambassdors and staff from the Zoo Education program to educate guests of all ages.



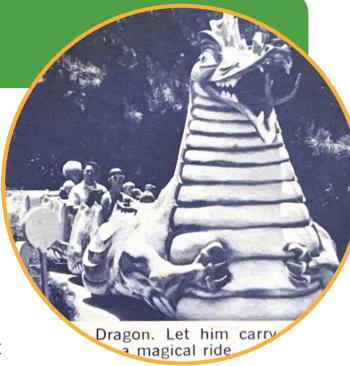

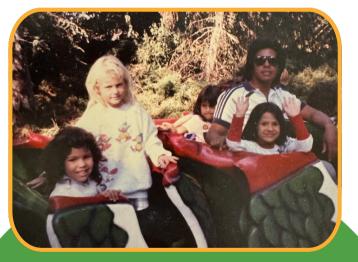
- Since 2014, over 30,000 older adults have participated in the Senior Safari program which promotes healthy and active living for older adults.

Danny the Dragon's new storyline embraces the big idea "Near & Far," taking Danny on a journey through different lands while also traveling back "home." Archways and panels will be gateways to different lands that parallel some of Happy Hollow's own animal habitats. Visitors of all ages will delight at recognizing animals species that live in each region as well as spotting surprise elements in the transition areas between zones. Visitors accompany Danny on a journey that begins with departing Happy Hollow and traveling from forests to farmlands and on to fairylands and mystical dragonlands. Refreshing Danny will also include adding shade created by dragonthemed overhead sails for visitors as they wait in line.

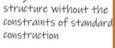

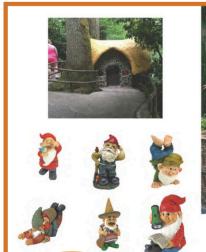
