A Dream For Danny

Capital Campaign Executive Summary



In January 2023, Happy Hollow Foundation partnered with CCS Fundraising, a fundraising consulting firm, to conduct a feasibility study in preparation for its first-ever capital campaign. The study assessed the readiness of the staff, the board and the donor community to embark on a significant fundraising effort aligned with the needs of Happy Hollow Park & Zoo. Together, the foundation leadership and park and zoo management teams identified five potential projects to test with donors—ensuring that donor priorities aligned with the most meaningful opportunities for impact—recognizing that without donor interest and investment, none could move forward. This process ensured that the opportunities pursued were both mission-driven and supported by the donor community, setting the stage for success.

At the conclusion of the six-month feasibility study, data gathered through interviews and e-surveys with key stakeholders—including donors, board members, Happy Hollow Park & Zoo staff, and leadership from the City of San José's Department of Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Services—revealed the top three donor-supported project priorities:

1. River Otter Exhibit

2. Danny the Dragon

3. Adventure Grove

In consideration of the foundation's limited history of large-scale fundraising and donor enthusiasm for each project, CCS recommended Danny the Dragon as the initial priority. Beloved by generations of guests, Danny was a clear donor favorite, with an appropriate price point and an attainable goal for a first campaign.

In January 2024, Happy Hollow Foundation once again partnered with CCS to create a comprehensive fundraising plan with clear objectives and guiding principles—ensuring the campaign embodied the spirit of Happy Hollow, rooted in joy, gratitude and a shared commitment to reimagining the Danny the Dragon ride.



By September 2024, the foundation embarked on the **"A Dream for Danny" Capital Campaign**—an extraordinary undertaking that stretched our capacity in new ways. Even as regular fundraising activities and programs continued, foundation leaders, staff, donors and campaign volunteers rallied together with remarkable effort and focus. The campaign was fueled by the overwhelming donor interest and support for Danny the Dragon, whose storybook charm and place in Happy Hollow history inspired gifts both large and small. This community-wide commitment reflected the depth of love for Danny, the belief in Happy Hollow's future and the power of donors to make that future possible.

CAMPAIGN LEADERSHIP AND ORGANIZATION

Strong leadership was critical to this campaign’s success. The campaign was led by highly trained volunteers and internal senior leaders and was supported by staff including bringing on a dedicated Campaign Manager to ensure that the campaign maintained a high level of activity through careful monitoring of campaign progress and a focus on campaign objectives.

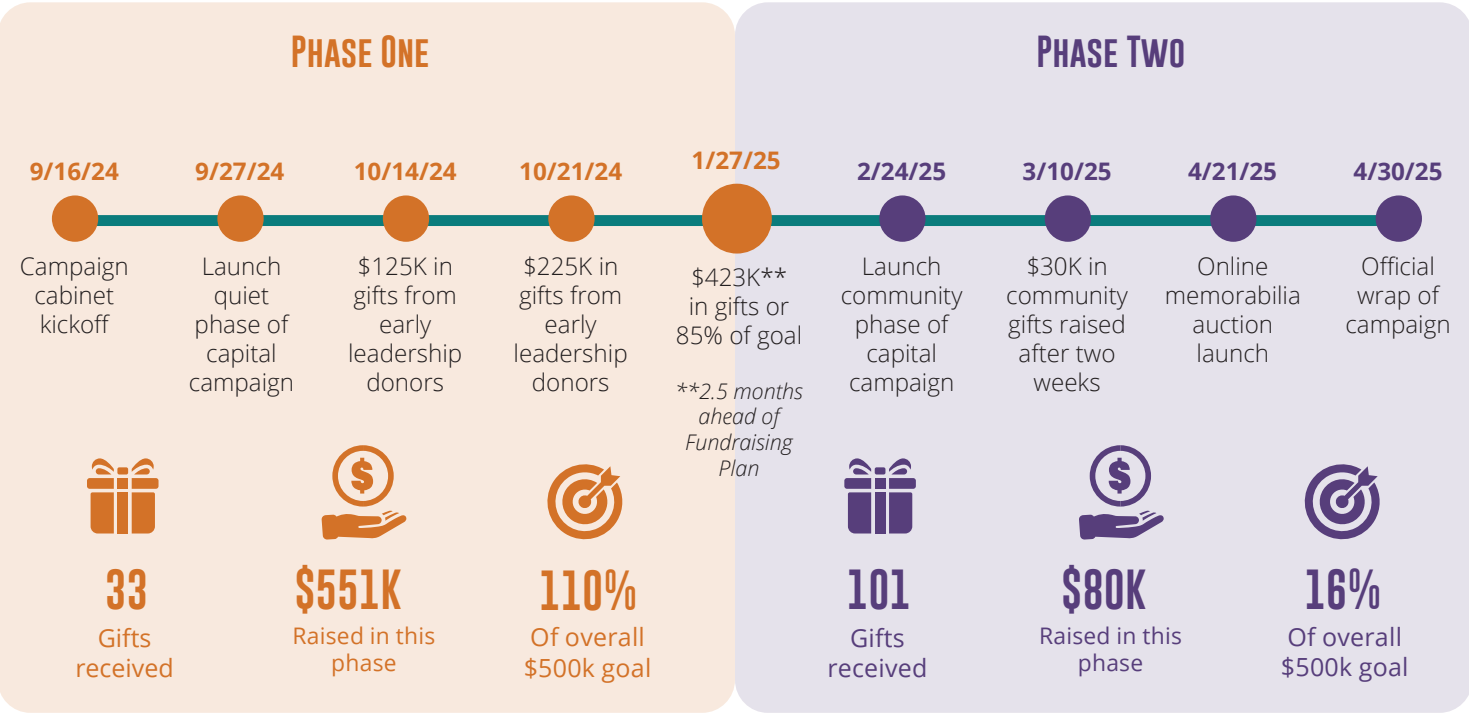


CAMPAIGN FINANCIAL SUMMARY

Thanks to the tremendous generosity of our community—and the excitement around giving Danny the Dragon train the refresh it deserved—our capital campaign was a resounding success. We not only exceeded our fundraising goals, but we also reached them ahead of schedule. This achievement reflected both Danny’s timeless significance and the community’s shared commitment to preserving Happy Hollow’s magic for future generations.

A Past Worth Preserving

Danny the Dragon treasures spark joy and nostalgia



For more than 60 years, the Danny the Dragon train ride took families on a journey through storybook scenes that evoked laughter, wonder and memories that lasted a lifetime. Who could forget the Dwarf Cottage, the Yellow Brick Road or Dorothy's House? Or the Three Little Pigs, giant pandas and the many characters that made the ride so beloved?

This past spring, Happy Hollow Foundation gave our community a chance to take home a piece of that history with the **Danny the Dragon Memorabilia Online Auction**. For one week, the public could bid on iconic scenic pieces from the ride's 63-year storyline including statues, signs and whimsical structures that once delighted children and parents alike.

The response was extraordinary. Each item found a new home, and each new owner carried away not just memorabilia, but a piece of Happy Hollow's heart and history.

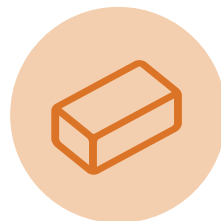

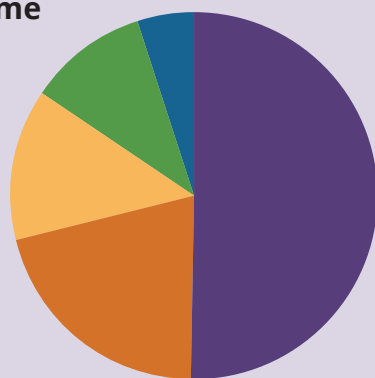

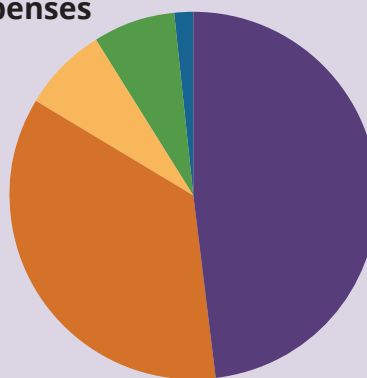
